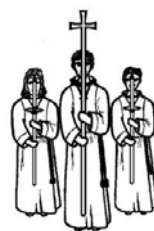

St. Anne's Capital Campaign, 'Worship, Connect, Grow & Serve -Building the Next 100 Years' Campaign was kicked off in January 2015 with three goals:

- o Pay down our church debt
- o Support the Diocese capital campaign
- o Assist with the continuation of church ministries

Our stretch goal was \$1.5M and our minimum goal was \$1M. The total amount pledged to date is \$846,000. As of December, 2016, \$488,772 has been fulfilled (58% of the total). The remaining 42% (\$357,228) is still to be collected in the remaining 12 months of the campaign which ends at the end of 2017. We are roughly 66% through the campaign schedule and have collected 58% of the pledged funds. Pretty much on schedule. Thank you. This update is simply to remind parishioners to assess where you are in your donation schedule and to plan now to stay on schedule or to re-schedule to finish on time, if you can.

If you were unable to make a pledge or support the campaign back in 2014, and can support the cause now, this is a fine time to complete a pledge card. If you would like a personal and confidential campaign member to come to your home and discuss the campaign with you, please call Danette Jolly at 925-550-2748.

Your support is key to the success of ongoing ministries.

La Campaña de Santa Ana de, 'Venerar, Conectarse, Crecer y Servir - Construyendo los próximos 100 años se inició en Enero de 2015 con tres objetivos:

- o pagar la deuda de nuestra iglesia
  - o Apoyar la campaña capital de la Diócesis
  - o Asistir a la continuación de los ministerios de la Iglesia
- Nuestra meta era \$1.5 M con un objetivo mínimo de \$1M. El monto total comprometido hasta la fecha es de \$846.000. A partir de octubre de 2016, \$488,772 han sido cumplido (un 58% del total). El 42% restante (\$375.228) todavía debe ser recolectado en los restantes 12 meses de la campaña que termina a finales de 2017. Estamos aproximadamente a 66% del término de la campaña y hemos recolectado el 58% de los fondos prometidos. Más o menos a tiempo. Gracias.
