Epiphany Blessing of a Home

Prior to the twentieth century, Christmas did not last one day. The Twelve Days of Christmas were celebrated between Christmas and Epiphany. They were called "Smoke Nights" because people went through their houses and barns burning incense to bless their homes in preparation for the new year. The word "epiphany" means "manifestation"; the feast celebrates how God revealed his Son to the world. After each room of the house was incensed and blessed, the father of the family took a piece of blessed chalk and wrote over the door of every room that led out from the house to the open: 20+C+M+B+19 This stood for "Anno Domini 2019 - Caspar, Melchior, Balthasar" and meant that the three kings or magi in this year of our Lord 2019 (or whatever year) protected the house from all evil. It also stands for *Christus mansionem benedicat* [Christ bless this home]. Grab some chalk and your family, go to your front door and bless your home with the following blessing:

All: make the Sign of the Cross.

Leader: *"Peace be to this house and to all who dwell here, in the name of the Lord.*

All: *Blessed be God forever.*

Reader: *In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be.... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw his glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth. (John 1:1-3.14)*

Leader: Let us pray.

O Lord God, bless this chalk, make it helpful to us. Grant that we who use it with faith and inscribe with it upon the entrance of our homes may enjoy physical health and spiritual protection. Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Using the chalk, write on the outside of your house, above or next to an entrance: **20+C+M+B+19** (Each number/letter could be written by a different member of the household.)

Leader: *Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness and the keeping of your law. Fill us with the light of Christ that our love for each other may go out to all. We ask this through Christ our Lord. All: Amen.*

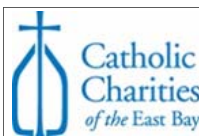
