Nurses Notes

Make A New Years Resolution To Get An Eye Examination For Glaucoma.

Glaucoma is an eye disease that causes loss of sight by damaging a part of the eye called the optic nerve. When the optic nerve is damaged, peripheral vision begins to diminish. If left untreated, over time, glaucoma may also damage central vision. Unfortunately once vision is lost to this it cannot be restored. By the time symptoms appear, some permanent damage to the eye has usually occurred.

Glaucoma is the second leading cause of blindness in the world and the leading cause of blindness in African American and Hispanic populations in America. Although there is no cure, if detected early and treated early, the effects of vision loss can be diminished.

Risk factors for Glaucoma include

- Age: Those that are over 40 and older are more likely to develop glaucoma. The older you are the greater risk your risk.
- Race: Glaucoma is the leading cause of blindness in African American and Hispanic populations in America.
- Family History: If you have a parent or sibling who has glaucoma, you are likely to develop the disease
- Diabetes: People with Diabetes have a higher risk for developing the disease
- Nearsightedness: People who are very nearsighted are a greater risk.
- Eye Injury or Surgery: Those who have had eye surgery or eye injuries may develop secondary glaucoma
- Steroid Medication: Steroids may increase the risk of glaucoma when used for extended periods of time.
