Nurses Notes:

Thyroid Disease in Women: Know the Symptoms

Thyroid disorders are much more common in women than in men, but are often missed or confused with other conditions.

The thyroid is a small but powerful gland in your neck that produces hormones that control your metabolism influencing your heart rate, body temperature, bones, digestion and reproductive system.

The most common thyroid disorders:

- Underactive thyroid (Hypothyroid) can occur at any age, but most common after age 50. It occurs when the thyroid doesn't make enough thyroid hormones. A woman may start to feel weak and run down with possible weight gain and constipation.

Symptoms of Hypothyroid

- Fatigue
