St. Anne's Capital Campaign, 'Worship, Connect, Grow & Serve -Building the Next 100 Years' Campaign was kicked off in January 2015 with three goals:

- o Pay down our church debt
- o Support the Diocese capital campaign
- o Assist with the continuation of church ministries

Our stretch goal was \$1.5M and our minimum goal was \$1M. The total amount pledged to date is \$846,000. As of December, 2016, \$488,772 has been fulfilled (58% of the total). The remaining 42% (\$357,228) is still to be collected in the remaining 12 months of the campaign which ends at the end of 2017. We are roughly 66% through the campaign schedule and have collected 58% of the pledged funds. Pretty much on schedule. Thank you. This update is simply to remind parishioners to assess where you are in your donation schedule and to plan now to stay on schedule or to re-schedule to finish on time, if you can.

If you were unable to make a pledge or support the campaign back in 2014, and can support the cause now, this is a fine time to complete a pledge card. Your support is key to the success of ongoing ministries.
