Nurses Notes:

Thyroid Disease in Women: Know the Symptoms

Overactive Thyroid- Hyperthyroid

Is a disorder in which your thyroid gland makes and releases more thyroid hormone than your body needs.

Your thyroid gland is located in the front of your neck. Hormones released by the thyroid affect nearly every part of your body from your brain to your skin and muscles. They play a crucial role in controlling how your body uses energy (your metabolism). This includes how your heart beats and how you burn calories.

The causes of hyperthyroidism include:

- Graves' disease- an autoimmune condition where the body's immune system creates an antibody that causes the gland to make an excessive amount of thyroid hormone-this disease runs in families.
- Thyroiditis-an inflammation of the thyroid in which a virus or problem with the immune system causes the gland to swell, leaking thyroid hormone into the bloodstream
 - ⇒ Subacute-sudden, painful,thyroid usually heals on its own
 - ⇒ Postpartum-affects women after pregnancy. One to two women out of 10 develop after having a baby. Lasts a month or two. Silent: Similar to postpartum but not related to pregnancy.
 - ⇒ Thyroid produces too much hormone but patients do not develop a painful thyroid gland. May develop hypothyroidism afterwards
- Thyroid nodule. One or more lumps, or nodules, can grow in the thyroid gland, gradually increasing the gland's activity and amount of thyroid hormone in your blood.
