It is a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday, through which we attain redemption.

There is no need to become paranoid or obsessive but with a little common sense and good practices we can reduce the spread of the flu in the community. Thank you.



Alcohol Use Disorder Treatment

Women have lower levels of specific enzymes that break alcohol down in the stomach and liver. As a result, women absorb more alcohol in bloodstream. The blood alcohol concentration (BAC) will be higher in a woman than a man.

That's why one drink for a woman is said to have TWICE the physical impact as one drink for a man.

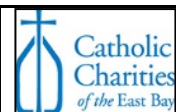

Like CPR, **Mental Health First Aid** prepares people to interact with a person in crisis and connect them with help. Our **Experience Hope Training Institute** teaches basic restorative and trauma-responsive philosophies and practices.

Many people with mental health struggles find solace in their faith. But church members or staff may not know how to respond to their struggles or help in a crisis. This training offers tools and answers to questions like, "What do I do?" or "Where can someone find help?"

This course is appropriate for anyone who wants to learn how to help someone who may be experiencing a mental health-related crisis or problem. Participants can use the skills learned in their daily lives, including within their own families, churches, or neighborhoods. 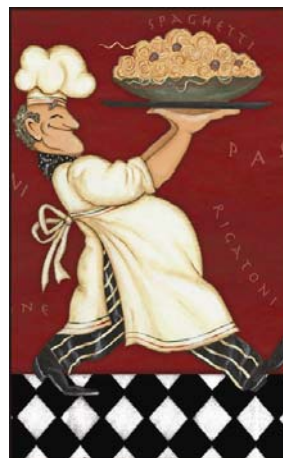
