February 1, 2017 St. Anne Community Blood Drive Results

The good news is 37 donors showed up to donate. THANK YOU! You do make a difference and you are Heroes! As a result of your generosity we collected 30 usable units which could affect a possible 90 lives.

The bad news is that the 37 donors included 12 walk-ins. This means that of the 60 people who signed up for appointments only 25 showed up. 35 did not show up.

Since our first Red Cross Blood Drive in 2011, our 18 Red Cross Blood Drives saw 958 donors donate 784 usable units affecting a possible 2,262 lives.

Our blood drives could not have enjoyed the success they have been without our volunteers generously donating their time and efforts. Volunteers arranged for the Grand Hall, arranged for the use of the sound system, put the notices in the bulletin, signed up donors, set up the Grand Hall for the blood drive, greeted and signed donors into the blood drive, and staffed the Red Cross canteen visiting with and monitoring donors until they were okay to move on. After the blood drive was over our volunteers cleaned and set up the Grand Hall for Sunday Mass. All of this effort and work not only makes the St. Anne Community Blood Drives possible and a success, but leads to a more enjoyable blood donation experience for the donor.
