Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are obligatory days of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year. **Fridays in Lent** are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious." -U.S. Bishops Conference

Miércoles de ceniza & Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayuno es obligatorio para todos los mayores de 18 años hasta los 6°. Ayuno permite a la persona solo comer una comida completa al día. Con dos porciones menores que equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia de comer carne es obligación desde los 14 años de edad. **Los Viernes de Cuaresma** obliga a no comer carne desde los 14 años de edad.

Nurses Notes

HEART DISEASE IN WOMEN

Heart disease. It's the No. 1 killer of women and is more deadly than all forms of cancer

Symptoms of a heart attack:

- Uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain in the center of your chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or goes away and comes back.
- Pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.
- Shortness of breath, with or without chest discomfort.
- Other signs such as breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea or light-headedness.

As with men, the most common heart attack symptom in women is chest pain or discomfort. But it's important to note that women are more likely to experience the other common symptoms, particularly shortness of breath, nausea/vomiting and back or jaw pain.

What to do during a heart attack

If you experience any of these signs or symptoms:

Do not wait to call for help. Dial 9-1-1, make sure to follow the operator's instructions and get to a hospital right away. Do not drive yourself or have someone drive you to the hospital unless you have no other choice. Try to stay as calm as possible and take deep, slow breaths while you wait for the emergency responders
