Women and Heart Disease

- Heart disease is the leading cause of death for women in the United States, killing 289,758 women in 2013—that's about 1 in every 4 female deaths.
- Although heart disease is sometimes thought of as a "man's disease," around the same number of women and men die each year of heart disease.
- Risk Factors
High blood pressure, high LDL cholesterol, and smoking are key risk factors for heart disease. About half of Americans (49%) have at least one of these three risk factors. Other medical conditions and lifestyle choices can also put people at a higher risk for heart disease, including: Diabetes, Overweight and obesity, Poor diet, Physical inactivity, Excessive alcohol use

Symptoms

While some women have no symptoms, others experience angina (dull, heavy to sharp chest pain or discomfort), pain in the neck/jaw/throat or pain in the upper abdomen or back. These may occur during rest, begin during physical activity, or be triggered by mental stress. Reduce heart disease by reducing your risk factors

Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year. **Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year. *"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious."* -U.S. Bishops Conference

Días de Ayuno y Abstinencia durante la Cuaresma

Los Viernes de Cuaresma obliga a no comer carne desde los 14 años de edad. **Viernes Santo** esta día obligatorio de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayuno es obligatorio para todos los mayores de 18 años hasta los 6°. Ayuno permite a la persona solo comer una comida completa al día. Con dos porciones menores que equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia de comer carne es obligación desde los 14 años de edad.

"Nadie debe ser escrupuloso si no puede cumplir con algo en día de penitencia, no es considerado serio; mejor dicho si no puede cumplir con ninguna penitencia entonces si es considerado serio" -U.S. Bishops Conference

Email Scam: Please be aware of an ongoing phishing scam involving emails and texts purportedly from priests or parish/Chancery staff. This scam has hit many parishes across the United States. The email or text purports to be from a person the target knows, such as one's pastor, a parish staff member, the bishop or someone else from the Church. If the target responds to the fake email or text, the sender will follow up with a request for some sort of monetary assistance, often for gift cards or iTunes cards with an offer to pay the target back. It is truly unfortunate cyber criminals attempt to exploit the generous nature of our community. Sending emails or texts asking for cash or gifts cards is not how priests, parishes or the Diocese of Oakland seeks financial assistance for our work. If you receive an email or text from a trusted church personnel asking for assistance, confirm by calling that person and do not respond to the email or text. Es realmente desafortunado delincuentes cibernéticos intentan explotar la naturaleza generosa de nuestra comunidad. We also assist any St. Anne parishioner no matter where they live. We meet monthly for organizational purposes. **Our next monthly meeting is Wednesday, March 27, 2019 at 10:15 am in room 2.** Visitors and those considering joining our group are welcome to attend.

During the month of January our Vincentians interviewed 2 families consisting of a total of 4 adults. Their needs were partially met by providing them with bags of food, gas cards and gift cards. The clients were also given information about other community services and encouraged to participate in the Delta Christian Community Food Pantry (DCCFP).

We would also like to note that each Lenten Season, Catholic Relief Services for the Diocese of Oakland sponsors the Rice Bowl change and cash banks fundraiser we see here at St. Anne's Parish each year. 75% of the proceeds from this collection taken at all Diocesan parishes is used for Catholic Relief Services work.
