Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fast-ing allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious." -U.S. Bishops Conference

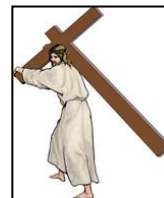

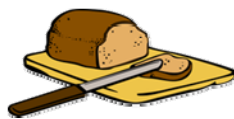

Get help right away by calling 911 or going to the nearest Emergency Room. hospitals have medication that can effectively treat a stroke, increase your chance of survival, and help reduce damage. But it needs to be given right away.

Some guidelines to determine if you or someone else is having a stroke:

Is the person experiencing loss of balance? Vision loss in one or both eyes?

Does one side of the face droop?

Does one arm drift down when the person is asked to hold up both arms?

Is the patient Unable to repeat a sentence?
