Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious."

COLORECTAL CANCER CONT.

Symptoms

Many cases of colon cancer have no symptoms. The following symptoms, however, may indicate colon cancer:

- Abdominal pain and tenderness in the lower abdomen
- Blood in the stool
- Diarrhea, constipation, or other change in bowel habits
- Intestinal obstruction
- Narrow stools
- Unexplained anemia
- Weight loss with no known cause

Testing

With proper screening, colon cancer can be detected before symptoms develop-when it is most curable.

- Your doctor will perform a physical exam of your abdomen and rectum
- A fecal occult blood test may detect small amounts of blood in the stool
- Imaging tests include Sigmoidoscopy and Colonoscopy-Only the Colonoscopy can see the entire colon.

Prevention

Colon cancer can almost always be caught in its earliest and most curable stages by colonoscopy. Most men and women age 50 and older should have a colon cancer screening. Pre cancerous polyps can be found with this screening and removed to prevent colon cancer.

Dietary and lifestyle changes are important. Some evidence suggests that low-fat and high-fiber diets may reduce your risk of colon cancer.
