Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year. **Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious." -U.S. Bishops Conference

#### **How to say goodbye to our loved ones, Part I**

Saying good-bye to a dying relative or friend -- what to talk about, when, and how -- doesn't come naturally to most adults. The irony: All such conversations ask of us, ultimately, is what people appreciate hearing at any time of life: words of candor, reassurance, and love. I offer some suggestions.

#### Regrets and lessons from grieving survivors

It's hard to say goodbye, but the number one regret is putting off meaningful conversations. It's hard to predict when the final hour is approaching, so that they can time their good-byes. This is dangerous because it's nearly impossible to predict the final breath. "Dying people have the uncanny ability to choose the moment of death, and it's not uncommon for them to spare those they love the most or feel protective of by waiting until those people leave the room,"

Dying people want to hear four very specific messages from their loved ones, says palliative-care physician Ira Byock, author of *The Four Things That Matter Most*: "Please forgive me." "I forgive you." "Thank you." "I love you."

Perhaps you saw the beautiful article in the February 6 Discovery Bay Press about our Krockpot Brigade. Thanks to Linea Jessup for her attention to this wonderful service that has been going for 11 years. Sharon Bonney, the Hospitality Director, gives us more details about how you can lend a much needed hand.

### Cooks Needed

The Krockpot Brigade is in desperate need of additional cooks to serve our families going through chemo and radiation treatments. The Brigade is one of the oldest programs of Kaleidoscope and it has served over 5000 meals in the last 11 years. Over the years it has had an average of 30 to 40 cooks on the cooks list with 20 cooks active at any time. Currently we have 20 cooks with less than half of them actively cooking. We have four families receiving meals each week and we are having a hard time filling all the available dates.

If you have been a cook previously, if you thought you might like to cook but just never acted on that thought, if you know of friends or acquaintances who might want to cook, now is the time to step up and volunteer. You will be welcomed to our team with joyous hearts and your heart will swell with the love and appreciation you will receive from the families.

Every month, Margory Soltani, the Krockpot Brigade Coordinator, sends an email listing the families we serve and the dates we need cooks. You request your preferred family and the dates you want to cook. Margory will assign you those dates if you are the first to ask for that date. If not, she will contact you with other available dates still unfilled and you can select from that list. Cooking at least once a month would be very helpful right now, but you decide how often you want to cook and for which family or families.
