Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious."

Nadie debe ser escrupuloso en este caso, si no cumple con los días de penitencia no se considera serio, pero si no cumple con ninguno de lo requerido o con algo se es considerado serio,

Nurses Notes

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Disaster can strike quickly, without warning. It can force you to evacuate your neighborhood or confine you to your home. You could be without basic services—water, gas, electricity or telephones. The best way to make your family and your home safer is to be prepared before disaster strikes.

THREE STEPS TO PREPAREDNESS

1. Get a Kit 2. Make a Plan 3. Be Informed

Step One: Get a Kit

At a minimum, have the basic supplies listed below. Keep supplies in an easy-to-carry emergency preparedness kit that can be used at home or take with you in case you must evacuate.

- Water—one gallon per person, per day (3 day supply for evacuation, 2-weeks for home)
- Food-non-perishable (3 days for evacuation, 2-weeks for home)
- Flashlight, Battery-powered radio (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible), with extra batteries
- First Aid Kit & Medications (7days supply) and medical items
- Multipurpose tool- to turn off gas or water
- Sanitation & personal hygiene items
- Copies of personal documents (med list & information, passports, birth certificates, deed, insurance policies)
- Cell phone with chargers
- Family & emergency contact information
- Extra cash
- Emergency blanket, Extra clothing, Rain gear. Towels
- Map of the area
- Manual can opener
- Matches
- Pet supplies and baby supplies
- Work gloves
- Whistle, extra car keys, extra house keys

PLEASE- Remember to use the phone in the office or at the AV area in the hall and not a cell phone to call 911. Your cell phone will reach Sacramento CHP and precious time will be wasted.
