### Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

**Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

**Fridays in Lent** are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

*"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious."* -U.S. Bishops Conference

Viernes Santo es día obligatorio de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayuno es obligatorio para todos los mayores de 18 años hasta los 6°. Ayuno permite a la persona solo comer una comida completa al día. Con dos porciones menores que equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia de comer carne es obligación desde los 14 años de edad.

**Los Viernes de Cuaresma** obliga a no comer carne desde los 14 años de edad.

#### IT'S ALLERGY SEASON

As spring begins, so does allergy season.

#### Allergens

Allergens are all around us. Allergens are found both indoor and outdoor like molds, and fungus. Weeds, grasses, flowers and, animal dander's from dogs, cats, birds and others. Dust and dust mites, and irritants like chemicals, perfumes, aerosol sprays and pollution. These are also called triggers. It is important to avoid triggers that can cause your symptoms.

#### Symptoms

The most common symptoms include sneezing, coughing, wheezing, runny noses, and itchy watery eyes.

#### Treatment

Your provider will probably recommend a nose spray (this helps to stop the allergies at the first target) and an allergy medicine like Allegra, or Zyrtec. Using these together will be more effective than using just one or the other.
