Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is a day of both fast and abstinence.

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

“No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious.” -U.S. Bishops Conference

Cuaresma Días De ayuno & Abstinencia

Viernes Santo es día de ayuno y vigilia (abstinencia de la carne) obligatorios. El ayunar es obligatorio para todos quienes han cumplido 18 años y aun no cumplido 60 años. El ayunar permite a una persona comer una comida entera. Se pueden tomar dos comidas más pequeñas, que no iguallen a una comida entera. La vigilia (abstinencia de la carne)) es obligatoria para todos quienes han cumplido 14 años.

Los Viernes en la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de vigilia (abstinencia de la carne) completa para todos quienes han cumplido 14 años.

Nadie debe ser escrupuloso en este caso, si no cumple con los días de penitencia no se considera serio, pero si no cumple con ninguno de lo requerido o con algo se es considerado serio,

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Disaster can strike quickly, without warning. It can force you to evacuate your neighborhood or confine you to your home. You could be without basic services—water, gas, electricity or telephones. The best way to make your family and your home safer is to be prepared before disaster strikes.

THREE STEPS TO PREPAREDNESS

- 1. Get a Kit 2. Make a Plan 3. Be Informed**

Step Two: Make a Plan

Meet with your family or household members.

Discuss how to prepare and respond to emergencies that are most likely to happen where you live, learn, work and play.

Most likely in our area would be flooding or earthquake.

Plan what to do in case you are separated during an emergency.

Choose two places to meet:

Right outside your home in case of sudden emergency, such as fire

Outside your neighborhood, in case you cannot return home or are asked to evacuate

Choose an out-of -area contact person.

Everyone should have emergency contact information in writing or programmed into cell phone

Plan what to do if you have to evacuate.

Decide where you would go and what route you would take to get there. You may decide to go to a motel/hotel, stay with friends or relatives or go to an evacuation shelter if necessary

Practice evacuating your home twice a year. Drive your planned route and plot alternate routes.

Plan ahead for your pets. Keep a phone list of pet-friendly hotels/motels and animal shelters.

You can plan to meet at the church.
