WHAT IS ASTHMA?

TRIGGERS

It's important to know and avoid triggers that can cause your symptoms,

- Indoor and outdoor allergens like molds and fungus,
- Trees, grasses, flowered and weeds
- Animal danders from dogs, cats, birds and others
- Dust and dust mites
- Viral infections like the common cold
- Irritants like perfumes, chemicals, aerosol sprays and pollution among others

TREATMENT

Bronchodilators that help to relax the muscles of the airway. These are taken to relieve sudden short term symptom and are sometimes referred to as rescue inhalers. Corticosteroids that help to reduce the inflammation can be taken in inhaled form, in pill form as in prednisone, or by injection. How to administer your inhaled medication Start by using your rescue inhaler with your spacer to help insure that your medicine is getting to your bronchioles instead of your tongue and back of your throat, then wait ten minutes before using your steroid spray to help insure your bronchioles are open to better accept the steroid spray.
