Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious." -U.S. Bishops Conference

Viernes Santo esta día obligatorio de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayuno es obligatorio para todos los mayores de 18 años hasta los 6°. Ayuno permite a la persona solo comer una comida completa al día. Con dos porciones menores que equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia de comer carne es obligación desde los 14 años de edad.

"Nadie debe ser escrupuloso si no puede cumplir con algo en día de penitencia, no es considerado serio; mejor dicho si no puede cumplir con ninguna penitencia entonces si es considerado serio" -U.S. Bishops Conference

### *Nurses Notes*

#### ALLERGIC ASTHMA

Asthma, is a narrowing of the airways with inflammation. You may be familiar with the signs and symptoms of shortness of breath, wheezing, and or coughing.

#### Treatment

First, avoid triggers such as pet danders, pollens from trees grasses and plants. 2nd, make an appointment to see your provider. Your provider may refer some patients to an allergist to asses for specific allergens.

Your provider may prescribe inhalers. The first being a bronchodilator like albuterol or ventolin to relax the muscles of the airway. These are taken to relieve sudden short term symptoms by opening the airway and are also referred to as rescue inhalers. Use a spacer to help insure your medicine gets to your bronchioles and not your tongue or back of your throat. The second medicine is the corticosteroid, sometimes referred to as a controller, that helps to reduce the inflammation of the airway and is given by inhaler, or in pill form like prednisone, or by injection. If you are given the inhaled kind then it should be taken 10 min after using the bronchodilator to help insure your bronchioles are open to better accept the steroid spray.
