### *Nurses Notes* **Vitamins**

The best way to get vitamins and minerals is from a balanced diet that includes fruits, vegetables, and whole grains. These foods also contain fiber, and phytochemicals such as antioxidants. Many studies show that vitamin supplements do not prolong life or prevent disease.

Having said that there are times when vitamin supplements might be needed.

- Women who are pregnant, breast feeding or considering becoming pregnant might need supplements such as prenatal vitamins, folic acid, calcium and iron to maintain a healthy development of a healthy baby and for your own health.
- Girls and women might benefit from extra calcium and vitamin D for strong bones. Talk to your doctor when considering iron as this can build up to cause toxic levels in your body.
- People 50 and over might need vitamin B 12, and should talk to their doctor about Vitamin D and calcium as well.
- People with special dietary concerns or restrictions
- People who have food allergies or vitamin deficiency or who follow a vegetarian diet, may benefit from taking supplements. Talk to your doctor about you specific needs.
