It is my burning desire that, during this Jubilee, the Christian people may reflect on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. It will be a way to re-awaken our conscience, too often grown dull in the face of poverty. And let us enter more deeply into the heart of the Gospel where the poor have a special experience of God's mercy. Jesus introduces us to these works of mercy in his preaching so that we can know whether or not we are living as his

disciples. Let us rediscover these corporal works of mercy; to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead. And let us not forget the spiritual works of mercy: to counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offences, bear patiently those who do us ill, and pray for the living and the dead.

Nurses Notes

Sleep Time Recommendations: What's Changed?

“The National Sleep Foundation has committed to regularly reviewing and providing scientifically rigorous recommendations,” says Max Hirshkowitz, PhD, Chair of the National Sleep Foundation Scientific Advisory Council. “The public can be confident that these recommendations represent the best guidance for sleep duration and health.”

A new range, “may be appropriate,” has been added to acknowledge the individual variability in appropriate sleep durations. The recommendations now define times as either (a) recommended; (b) may be appropriate for some individuals; or (c) not recommended.

The panel revised the recommended sleep ranges for all six children and teen age groups. A summary of the new recommendations includes:

- **Newborns (0-3 months)** : Sleep range narrowed to 14-17 hours each day (previously it was 12-18)
- **Infants (4-11 months)**: Sleep range widened two hours to 12-15 hours (previously it was 14-15)
- **Toddlers (1-2 years)**: Sleep range widened by one hour to 11-14 hours (previously it was 12-14)
- **Preschoolers (3-5)**: Sleep range widened by one hour to 10-13 hours (previously it was 11-13)
- **School age children (6-13)**: Sleep range widened by one hour to 9-11 hours (previously it was 10-11)
- **Teenagers (14-17)**: Sleep range widened by one hour to 8-10 hours (previously it was 8.5-9.5)
- **Younger adults (18-25)**: Sleep range is 7-9 hours (new age category)
- **Adults (26-64)**: Sleep range did not change and remains 7-9 hours
- **Older adults (65+)**: Sleep range is 7-8 hours (new age category)
