Nurses Notes: April is Food Safety month

Kitchen Towel Safety

If you cook at home, you probably use either a kitchen towel or paper towel to dry dishes, wipe up spills, or dry your hands. According to the USDA, kitchen towels are the number one source of cross contamination in the kitchen. Here are some guidelines to protect your family.

Hand washing is the first step to avoid spreading bacteria. Poorly washed hands can contaminate your kitchen towels with bacteria then contaminate any surface the towel touches. You should wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds at the start of cooking and after the following actions:

- Handling raw meat
- Handling raw meat packaging
- Handling raw eggs (even if you only touched the shell)
- Throwing away trash
- And after cooking

Never reuse paper towels. They are meant for single use only. When used Multiple times, bacteria can find itself onto the paper towel. When used once, that bacteria ends up in the trash.

Kitchen towels build up bacteria after multiple uses. To keep the bacteria from building up wash towels frequently in the hot cycle of your washing machine. This will remove the bacteria and stop the cross contamination. Keep multiple towels in your cabinet so you can use a new towel when the current towel is overused.

Kaleidoscope Krockpot Brigade

Perhaps you saw the beautiful article in the February 6 Discovery Bay Press about our Krockpot Brigade. Thanks to Linea Jessup for her attention to this wonderful service that has been going for 11 years. Sharon Bonney, the Hospitality Director, gives us more details about how you can lend a much needed hand.

Cooks Needed

The Krockpot Brigade is in desperate need of additional cooks to serve our families going through chemo and radiation treatments. The Brigade is one of the oldest programs of Kaleidoscope and it has served over 5000 meals in the last 11 years. Over the years it has had an average of 30 to 40 cooks on the cooks list with 20 cooks active at any time. Currently we have 20 cooks with less than half of them actively cooking. We have four families receiving meals each week and we are having a hard time filling all the available dates.

If you have been a cook previously, if you thought you might like to cook but just never acted on that thought, if you know of friends or acquaintances who might want to cook, now is the time to step up and volunteer. You will be welcomed to our team with joyous hearts and your heart will swell with the love and appreciation you will receive from the families.

Every month, Margory Soltani, the Krockpot Brigade Coordinator, sends an email listing the families we serve and the dates we need cooks. You request your preferred family and the dates you want to cook. Margory will assign you those dates if you are the first to ask for that date. If not, she will contact you with other available dates still unfilled and you can select from that list. Cooking at least once a month would be very helpful right now, but you decide how often you want to cook and for which family or families.
