Lent Days of Fast and Abstinence

Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence from meat for all who have completed their 14th year. **Good Friday** is an obligatory day of fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence from meat is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.
"No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe some penitential day is not considered serious; rather it is failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such, which is considered serious." -U.S. Bishops Conference

Los Viernes de Cuaresma obliga a no comer carne desde los 14 años de edad. **Viernes Santo** esta día obligatorio de ayuno y abstinencia. Ayuno es obligatorio para todos los mayores de 18 años hasta los 6°. Ayuno permite a la persona solo comer una comida completa al día. Con dos porciones menores que equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia de comer carne es obligación desde los 14 años de edad.

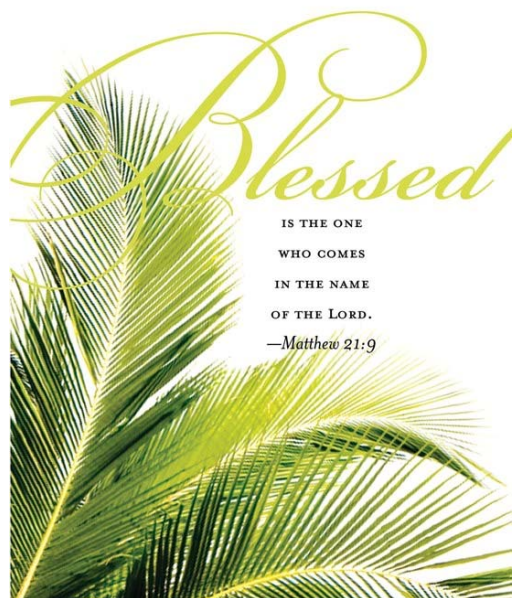

Sit with their charge while they run errands or have alone time. Run errands or prepare and separate a casserole into individual frozen containers.

Offer to take them out

If they're the sole caregiver, secure a trustworthy substitute so they can relax and leave worry behind a for a bit

Lend an ear.

Caregivers sometimes need to vent frustration or sorrow. No need to solve the problems; just listen attentively and let them know you care.

Continue to invite.

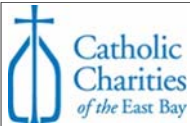

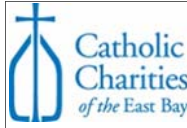
