Our geographic focus will be the counties of Alameda and Contra Costa, but clients served may be residents of Marin, San Francisco, and San Mateo counties as well. The Know-Your-Rights/Outreach Coordinator will also help clients get connected to legal services, whether through our offices or other trustworthy immigration legal services providers.

CCEB will provide access to trainings and support to help the Coordinator achieve Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) accredited status. BIA status is required to provide individual screenings for potential immigration relief.

Periodic travel to each of the three offices may be required for case rounds and staff meetings, as well as frequent travel throughout the East Bay for community events. Patients who are nearing end of life have a variety of needs that can be filled by volunteers. Some patients have little or no support and are in need of companionship. Volunteer visits can include reading, journaling, helping with hobbies and relieving family members and friends. Have you ever considered becoming a hospice volunteer? Volunteers must be at least 18 and have not suffered a close personal loss in the last 12 months. The commitment is usually 1-2 hours per week. Thorough training will be provided to help volunteers feel comfortable with their assignments. There are patients in *your* town who are awaiting volunteer assistance.
