April 6, 2016 Blood Drive Results

A special thank you to the 45 donors who showed up to donate. You do make a difference and you are Heroes! We collected 38 usable units which could affect up to 114 lives. For this drive the Red Cross allocated us 72 appointment slots and we had 68 donors sign up for appointments. Unfortunately, only 36 or 53% showed up for their appointment. We had 9 walk-ins. Since July 2011 the St. Anne Community Red Cross Blood Drives have seen 789 donors donate 640 usable units affecting 1,920 lives. This drive's 114 lives could not possibly be affected without the time and efforts of our volunteers. Volunteers arranged for the Grand Hall, arranged for the use of the sound system, put the notices in the bulletin, signed up donors, set up the Grand Hall for the blood drive, greeted and signed donors into the blood drive, and staffed the Red Cross canteen visiting with and monitoring the donors until they were okay to move on (6 donors experienced minor complications). After the blood drive was over our volunteers cleaned and set up the Grand Hall for Sunday Mass. All of this effort and work not only makes the St. Anne Community Blood Drives possible and a success, but leads to a more enjoyable blood donation experience for the donor. Thank you to Fr. Ron for the use of the facilities. Obviously, without the facilities none of this would be possible. Thank you to Frank Larrabee, Greg Moran, Paul Nielson, Maureen Murray, Lisa Promani, Jane Perry, Linda Jensen, Linda & Jack Thomas, Judy Konieczny and Jack Freschi for volunteering and assisting in the success of this blood drive. Para este evento e la Cruz Roja nos asignó 72 espacios para citas y tuvimos 68 donantes solicitando citas. Por desgracia, sólo 36 o el 53% llegaron a su cita. Tuvimos 9 personas que llegaron sin cita previa. Desde julio del 2011 el evento de donacion de sangre de la cruz roja en la comunidad de Santa Ana se han visto 789 donantes donar 640 unidades utilizables que afectarían a 1.920 vidas. Estas 114 vidas de nuestro ultimo evento no podría verse afectados sin el tiempo y esfuerzos de nuestros voluntarios. Los voluntarios organizaron el montaje y desmontaje de el gran salón, de el uso del sistema de sonido, pusieron los avisos en el boletín, registraron a los donantes, dieron la bienvenida a los donantes y organizaron al personal de la cantina de la Cruz Roja visitando y dando seguimiento a los donantes. (6 donantes experimentado complicaciones menores). Después del evento nuestros voluntarios limpiaron e hicieron el montaje para preparar el salón para la Misa del domingo. Todo este esfuerzo y trabajo no sólo hace que esta campaña en Santa Ana posible y sea todo un éxito, pero conduce a una experiencia más agradable de donación de sangre para el donante. Gracias al padre de Ron por el uso de las instalaciones. Obviamente, sin las instalaciones nada de esto sería posible.
