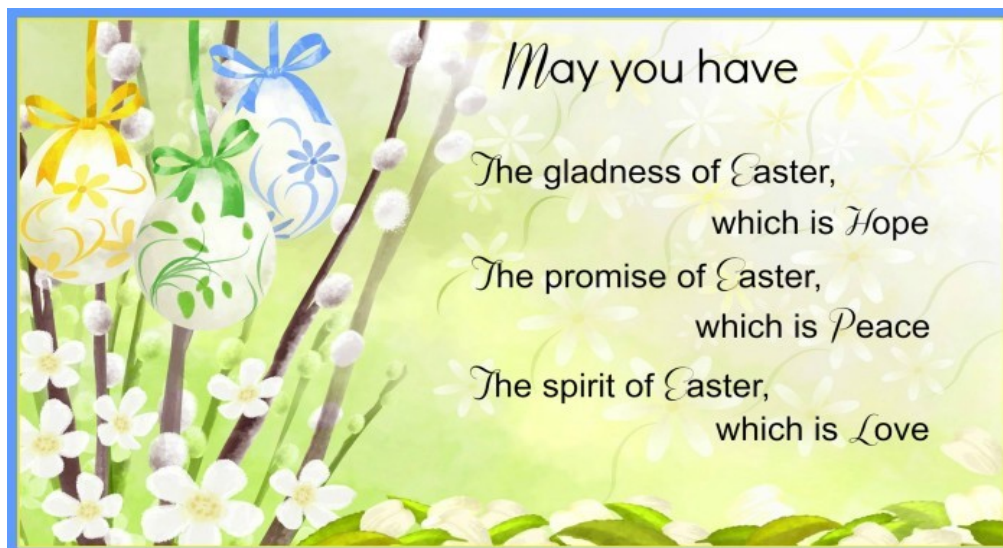

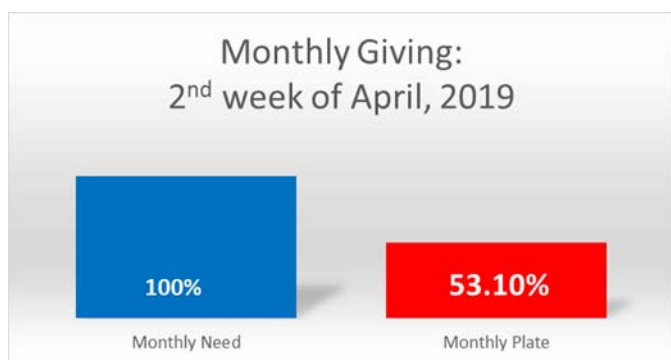

The parishioners of St. Anne Church continue to be most generous in their support of the efforts of our parish St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Society in helping those in need. **Our next monthly meeting is Wednesday, April 24, 2019 at 10:15 am in room 2.** Visitors and those considering joining our group are welcome to attend.

During the month of March our Vincentians interviewed 4 families who lived out of our area in addition to 3 families in our area. Those outside our area were referred to SVdP Conferences in their area and encouraged to contact them for assistance. We met with two homeless individuals who were partially helped by providing them with bags of food from our food pantry and food and gas gift cards. They were also given information about other community services and encouraged to participate weekly in the Delta Christian Community Food Pantry (DCCFP).

We also had a client who we recently helped. Due to our policy of requiring 6 months between the dates of helping the same individual, she was given information about other community services and encouraged to participate weekly in the Delta Christian Community Food Pantry (DCCFP).

Most of the help we are able to provide for those in need in our area comes from your generosity in giving to the second collection in months that have a fifth Sunday. **Thank you for your donations at the March 30/31 2nd collection. The next 5th Sunday 2nd collection for our parish SVdP Society is May 29th.** Last Sunday, the St. Anne's EDGE Youth Group presented our Saint Vincent de Paul Conference a check for \$1,271.43 that was received from donations through the Super Bowl for Charity event. 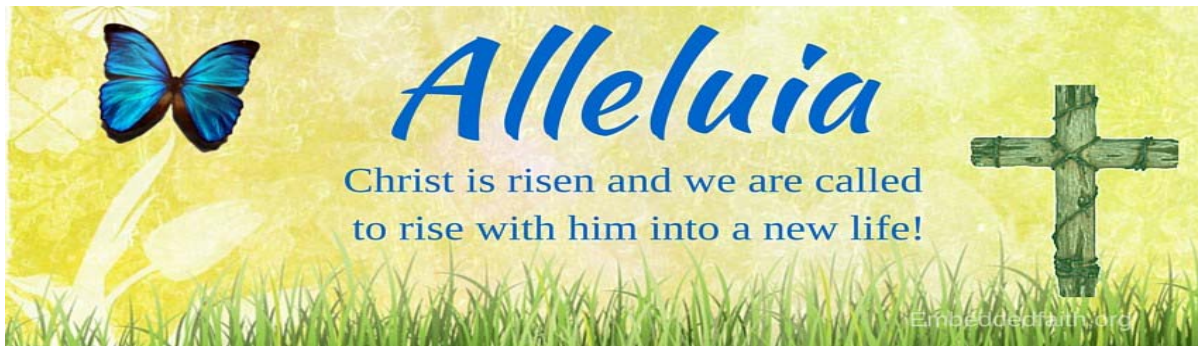

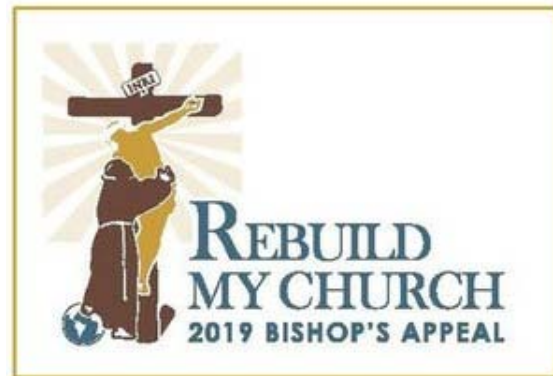
