#### Stress

Effective stress management is all about taking charge of your lifestyle, emotions, thoughts and the approach you take to cope with problems. Here are ten natural ways to lower everyday stress by adopting effective strategies for stress management.

1 MEDITATE.

The purpose here is to refocus attention while eliminating any jumbled up thoughts that may be crowding the mind.

exercise busts stress by pumping up endorphins, and improving the mood.

certain scents in nature can help elevate mood, reduce anxiety and promote focus and better concentration. Try lavender or Rosemary

4 BATHS

Soaking in warm water has a soothing effect on both the body as well as the mind.

5 MASSAGE

massage is used to relax tense muscles, reduce pain as well as improve circulation, all factors that can do wonders for the mind.

6 HERBAL TEAS

Passionflower has long been considered a folk remedy for anxiety and insomnia, but some studies have shown its potential to be comparable to certain drugs used to treat stress. Camomile teas is another tea to try.

7 SLEEP

A natural stress reducer is getting a good night's sleep. insufficient sleep leaves people irritable, cranky and on edge, whereas too much sleep will have the effect of making them sluggish and depressed. Find the right amount of time for you to feel well rested and ready for the day.

8 HEALTHY DIET

It has actually been proven that consuming junk food can make people depressed. Foods known to reduce stress include salmon, almonds and blueberries. Also try B vitamins.

9 CUT TIME SPENT WITH ELECTRONICS USE

Be it cell phones, computers, laptops at work or television at home. It is especially important to do this before sleep as it can cut down many of the problems related to insomnia and other sleep disorders.

10 ORGANIZE

This is because organization offers a natural sense of control and peace of mind. If an individual feels on edge in their own house, tidying up may help, since studies have shown that the mere sight of clutter can put people on edge.
