Autism Awareness

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a range of complex neurodevelopment disorders, characterized by social impairments, communication difficulties, and restricted, repetitive, and stereotyped patterns of behavior. The hallmark feature of ASD is impaired social interaction. As early as infancy, a baby with ASD may be unresponsive to people or focus intently on one item to the exclusion of others for long periods of time. A child with ASD may appear to develop normally and then withdraw and become indifferent to social engagement.

Children with an ASD may fail to respond to their names and often avoid eye contact with other people. They have difficulty interpreting what others are thinking or feeling because they can't understand social cues, such as tone of voice or facial expressions, and don't watch other people's faces for clues about appropriate behavior. They may lack empathy.

Many children with ASD engage in repetitive movements such as rocking and twirling, or in self-abusive behavior such as biting or head-banging. They also tend to start speaking later than other children and may refer to themselves by name instead of "I" or "me". Children with ASD don't know how to play interactively with other children.

Scientists aren't certain about what causes ASD, but it's likely that both genetics and environment play a role. Researchers have identified a number of genes associated with the disorder. Studies have found irregularities in several regions of the brain. The theory that parental practices are responsible for ASD has long been disproved.

There is no cure for ASD. Therapies and behavioral interventions are designed to remedy specific symptoms and can bring about substantial improvement. The ideal treatment plan coordinates therapies and interventions that meet the specific needs of individual children. Most health care professionals agree that the earlier the intervention, the better.

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Kaleidoscope Krockpot Brigade

Perhaps you saw the beautiful article in the February 6 Discovery Bay Press about our Krockpot Brigade. Thanks to Linea Jessup for her attention to this wonderful service that has been going for 11 years. Sharon Bonney, the Hospitality Director, gives us more details about how you can lend a much needed hand.

Cooks Needed

The Krockpot Brigade is in desperate need of additional cooks to serve our families going through chemo and radiation treatments. The Brigade is one of the oldest programs of Kaleidoscope and it has served over 5000 meals in the last 11 years. Over the years it has had an average of 30 to 40 cooks on the cooks list with 20 cooks active at any time. Currently we have 20 cooks with less than half of them actively cooking. We have four families receiving meals each week and we are having a hard time filling all the available dates.

If you have been a cook previously, if you thought you might like to cook but just never acted on that thought, if you know of friends or acquaintances who might want to cook, now is the time to step up and volunteer. You will be welcomed to our team with joyous hearts and your heart will swell with the love and appreciation you will receive from the families.

Every month, Margory Soltani, the Krockpot Brigade Coordinator, sends an email listing the families we serve and the dates we need cooks. You request your preferred family and the dates you want to cook. Margory will assign you those dates if you are the first to ask for that date. If not, she will contact you with other available dates still unfilled and you can select from that list. Cooking at least once a month would be very helpful right now, but you decide how often you want to cook and for which family or families.
