Nurses Notes

Pre Diabetes

Most people with prediabetes have no idea they are living with elevated blood sugars and that they are at an increased risk of heart attack and stroke. The potential for remission increases with early detection and intervention.

Prediabetes is a predictor of future diabetes. Yet, it can be reversed with healthy food choices, weight loss, exercise, medication and other lifestyle changes.

On average it takes 6.5 years to discover type 2 diabetes. The [Legacy Trial Results](#) demonstrated that early and aggressive treatment of diabetes results in decreased risk of eye, kidney, nerve disease, heart attack and possible death.

PreDiabetes lab results of A1c of 5.7-6.4% or Fasting BG of 100-125mg indicate pre diabetes diagnosis for diabetes: A1c of 6.5% + or Fasting BG of 126 x 2 or greater
