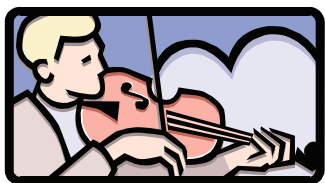

Nurses Notes

With warm weather and longer days comes more outdoor activities- picnics, hiking, biking, camping. Along with these activities comes exposure to ticks and possible exposure to Lyme disease.

May is Lyme Disease Awareness Month

What is Lyme disease?

Lyme disease is an infection caused by a spirochete ("SPY-ROH-KEET") that humans can get from the bite of an infected deer tick. The spirochete's scientific name is *Borrelia burgdorferi*. Lyme disease is called "The Great Imitator" because its symptoms mimic many other diseases. It can affect any organ of the body, including the brain and nervous system, muscles and joints, and the heart.

This tick has been found in 56 of the 58 counties in California.

California Nymphal (Nymphal ticks are the size of a poppy seed and have the highest infection rate) tick activities are highest April, May and June; however, California's mild climate puts Californians at risk all year!

Tick borne diseases are called the "Great Imitator" because the symptoms are often misdiagnosed as MS, ALS, chronic fatigue syndrome, fibromyalgia, Parkinson's, ADHS, Mental Illness to just name a few

If caught early and treated- treatment is often successful. The average Lyme patient takes 2 1/2 years to be diagnosed and sees on average of 8 to 10 physicians before diagnosis.
