### May is Arthritis Awareness Month

#### Rheumatoid Arthritis

Rheumatoid arthritis is a chronic inflammatory disorder that typically affects the small joints in your hands and feet. Unlike the damage of osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis affects the lining of your joints, causing a painful swelling that can eventually result in bone erosion and joint deformity.

An autoimmune disorder, rheumatoid arthritis occurs when your immune system mistakenly attacks your own body's tissues. In addition to causing joint problems, rheumatoid arthritis sometimes can affect other organs of the body—such as the skin, eyes, lungs and blood vessels. Although rheumatoid arthritis can occur at any age, it usually begins after age 40 and is much more common in women.

Treatment focuses on controlling symptoms and preventing joint damage.

Rheumatoid arthritis occurs when your immune system attacks the synovium—the lining of the membranes that surround your joints. The resulting inflammation thickens the synovium, which can eventually destroy the cartilage and bone within the joint.

The tendons and ligaments that hold the joint together weaken and stretch. Gradually, the joint loses its shape and alignment.

Doctors don't know what starts this process, although a genetic component appears likely. While your genes don't actually cause rheumatoid arthritis, they can make you more susceptible to environmental factors—such as infection with certain viruses and bacteria---that may trigger the disease.

Signs and symptoms of rheumatoid arthritis may include:

- Tender, warm, swollen joints
- Morning stiffness that may last for hours
- Firm bumps of tissue under the skin on your arms
- Fatigue, fever and weight loss

Early rheumatoid arthritis tends to affect your smaller joints first. As the disease progresses, symptoms often spread to the wrists, knees, ankles, elbows, hips and shoulders. Over time, rheumatoid arthritis can cause joints to deform and shift out of place.

Make an appointment with your doctor if you have persistent discomfort and swelling in your joints.

# Co-Director of Campus Ministry – Holy Names University, Oakland

Perhaps you saw the beautiful article in the February 6 Discovery Bay Press about our Krockpot Brigade. Thanks to Linea Jessup for her attention to this wonderful service that has been going for 11 years. Sharon Bonney, the Hospitality Director, gives us more details about how you can lend a much needed hand.

#### **Cooks Needed**

The Krockpot Brigade is in desperate need of additional cooks to serve our families going through chemo and radiation treatments. The Brigade is one of the oldest programs of Kaleidoscope and it has served over 5000 meals in the last 11 years. Over the years it has had an average of 30 to 40 cooks on the cooks list with 20 cooks active at any time. Currently we have 20 cooks with less than half of them actively cooking. We have four families receiving meals each week and we are having a hard time filling all the available dates.

If you have been a cook previously, if you thought you might like to cook but just never acted on that thought, if you know of friends or acquaintances who might want to cook, now is the time to step up and volunteer. You will be welcomed to our team with joyous hearts and your heart will swell with the love and appreciation you will receive from the families.

You request your preferred family and the dates you want to cook. Margory will assign you those dates if you are the first to ask for that date.
