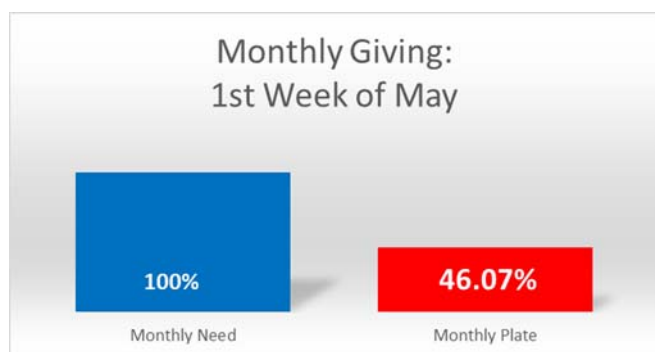

### **WHAT IS ASTHMA?**

If you have asthma, you are not alone - 1 in 12 people suffer from asthma. Asthma causes inflammation and narrowing of the airways, leading to reduced airflow in and out of the lungs. When you have asthma, the underlying inflammation leaves you more vulnerable to inhaled irritants or triggers. Exposure to these triggers can cause the muscles around the airways to constrict and cells in the airways to produce more mucus than normal, making them even narrower and reducing airflow. This can result in symptoms such as coughing and shortness of breath.

The signs, or symptoms, of asthma you may experience can include:

**Wheezing** – A whistling sound usually heard when you breathe in or out

**Coughing** – A cough that won't go away or comes and goes, often worse at night or early morning

**Shortness of breath** – Feeling as though you can't catch your breath

**Chest tightness** – Feeling as if something is squeezing or sitting on your chest
