Nurses Notes GLAUCOMA

What are the symptoms?

<u>Glaucoma</u> is often called the "silent thief of sight" because there are no outward signs or symptoms of its presence. The only way to determine if you have or are at risk for glaucoma is to make sure you get an annual <u>comprehensive eye exam</u>.

How is glaucoma treated?

- Vision loss or optic nerve damage caused by glaucoma cannot be reversed, which is why regular visits to your local eye doctor that allow early detection are so important. However, future damage can be controlled and potentially be prevented. For that, there are three forms of treatment for glaucoma:
- Eye drops, which are the most common form of treatment.
- Laser surgery, which can decrease or eliminate the need for eye drops.
- Surgical procedures, however, it is usually a last resort after eye drops and/or laser surgery have failed to be effective.
- Regular eye exams are the only way for your doctor to detect glaucoma at its earliest stage and early diagnosis of glaucoma is the key to saving sight.
