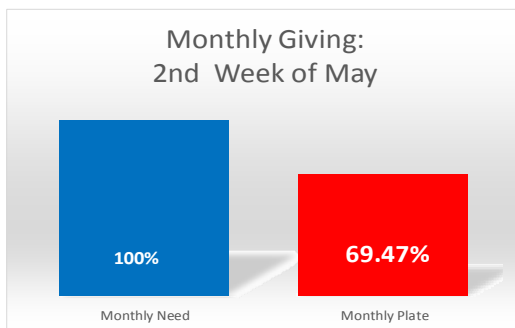

## May is Mental Health month

Mental health, erasing stigma

One of the hardest things for people to talk about is a mental health condition — 1 in 5 adults experience some form of condition, and 1 in 25 adults live with a serious mental health condition. Unfortunately, less than half of those who need help seek some form of treatment.

A mental health condition can range from persistent anxiety or depression to conditions such as eating disorders, phobias, or addictions. We create stigma when we disapprove or diminish someone because they "have a problem" without understanding what it means to have a mental health condition. Stigma is what keeps people from getting support, causing them to stay silent about mental health conditions.

Whether you or someone you love or care about is struggling, the first step towards getting help is to have a conversation. Empower someone you care about to speak up and find treatment.
