- Exercise helps to relieve stress and releases chemicals known to help you feel better
- Breathe, take a few minutes to deep breathe. Breathe in for 5 seconds, hold it for 5 seconds, exhale for 5 seconds and repeat 10 times.

- Unplug the electronics. This may help you to sleep better, to feel calm and to do things that are important to you.
