Nurses Notes

May is Melanoma/Skin Cancer Detection and Prevention Month

Prevention

Protection from sun exposure is important all year round, not just during the summer or at the beach. Ultraviolet (UV) rays can reach you on cloudy and hazy days, as well as bright, sunny days. The hours between 10 am and 4 pm (9 am to 3pm standard time) are the most hazardous for UV exposure in the continental US. UV rays are the greatest during late spring and early summer in North America.

The CDC recommends easy options for sun protection:

- Seek shade, especially during midday hours- Under an umbrella, tree or other shelter
- Wear clothing to protect exposed skin- Loose fitting long-sleeved shirts and long pants. A wet T-shirt offers much less UV protection than a dry one. Darker colors offer more protection than lighter colors.
- Wear a hat with a wide brim to shade the face, head, ears, and neck- For best protection have the brim go all the way around. A tightly woven fabric such as canvas works best. Avoid straw hats with holes that let sunlight through.
- Wear sunglasses that wrap around and block as close to 100% of both UVA and UVB rays as possible.
- Use sunscreen with sun protective factor (SPF) 15 or higher, and both UVA and UVB protection. Higher SPF indicates more protection. Remember that sunscreen wears off and should be reapplied every 2 hours and after you swim or do things that make you sweat.
