the variety of labels reveals that this is not a simple topic with a simple resolution. Presently, a bill is working its way through the California legislative process in the form of SB128, which would permit physician-assisted suicide. Bishop Barber, as all California bishops, strongly opposes this legislation. Our bishop asks that pastors and parishioners become knowledgeable advocates for the teachings of our faith with respect to human dignity and human life: "I urge all Catholics to educate themselves on the issue using the resources available from parishes, the Catholic press, and the diocesan website. ### *Nurses Notes:*

#### May is Hepatitis Awareness Month

Hepatitis C is an infection of the liver caused by the Hepatitis C virus. About 3.2 million people in the U.S. have the disease. But it causes few symptoms, so most of them don't know. There are many forms of Hepatitis C virus. The most common in the U.S. is type 1. None is more serious than any other, but they respond differently to treatment.

Many people with Hepatitis have no symptoms, but you could notice these: Jaundice (a condition that causes yellow eyes and skin as well as dark urine), Stomach pain, Loss of appetite, Nausea, and Fatigue.

Hepatitis C is spread through blood or body fluids of an infected person. You can catch it from:

- Sharing drugs and needles
- Having sex with an infected person
- Being stuck by infected needles
- Birth---a mother can pass it to a child

Hepatitis C isn't spread through food, water, or by casual contact.

The CDC recommends you get tested for the disease if you:

- Received blood from a donor who had the disease.
- Have ever injected drugs.
- Had a blood transfusion or organ transplant before July 1992.
- Received a blood product used to treat clotting problems before 1987.
- Were born between 1945 and 1965
- Have been on long-term kidney dialysis
- Have HIV
- Were born to a mother with Hepatitis C

You can get a blood test to see if you have the hepatitis C virus.

About 75% to 85% of people with Hepatitis C will develop a long-term infection called chronic hepatitis C. This is one of the top reasons people get liver transplants.

### Co-Director of Campus Ministry – Holy Names University, Oakland

Thanks to Linea Jessup for her attention to this wonderful service that has been going for 11 years. Sharon Bonney, the Hospitality Director, gives us more details about how you can lend a much needed hand.

#### **Cooks Needed**

The Krockpot Brigade is in desperate need of additional cooks to serve our families going through chemo and radiation treatments. The Brigade is one of the oldest programs of Kaleidoscope and it has served over 5000 meals in the last 11 years. Over the years it has had an average of 30 to 40 cooks on the cooks list with 20 cooks active at any time. Currently we have 20 cooks with less than half of them actively cooking. We have four families receiving meals each week and we are having a hard time filling all the available dates.

If you have been a cook previously, if you thought you might like to cook but just never acted on that thought, if you know of friends or acquaintances who might want to cook, now is the time to step up and volunteer. You will be welcomed to our team with joyous hearts and your heart will swell with the love and appreciation you will receive from the families.
