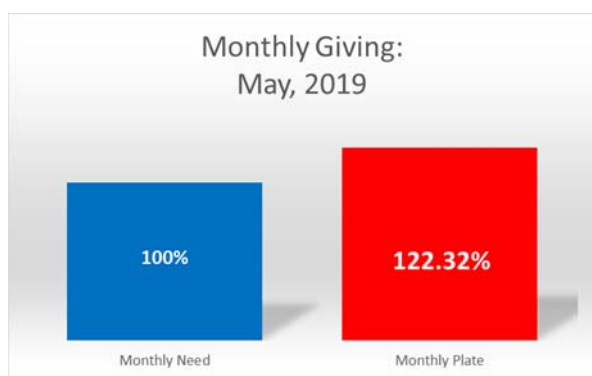

Educate ourselves and others

* Notice if someone needs help. Have they been absent a lot, or do you notice that they've been crying?

Ask **them if they'd like to talk about it. Be a good listener**

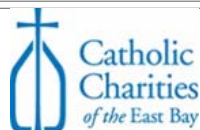
