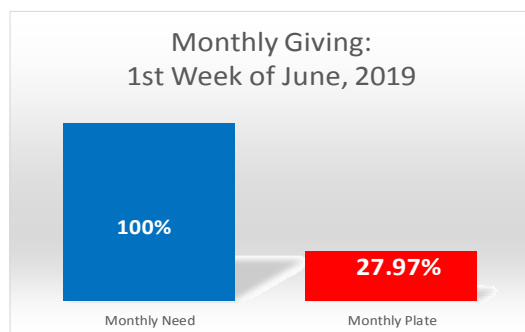

Nurses Notes

Q:High blood pressure can usually be cured. True or false?

A:False.

There is no cure for most cases of high blood pressure, but it can be effectively managed by changes in diet and lifestyle, and in some cases, medications. Lifestyle changes include a healthy diet with lower salt intake, regular physical activity, maintaining a healthy weight, managing **stress**, not **smoking**, limiting alcohol intake, and taking **prescription medications** as directed.

A:A normal blood pressure is defined as 120/80 mmHg or less.

Other important blood pressure ranges to know are:

- Prehypertension: **121-139/80-89**
- Stage 1 hypertension: **140-159/90-99**
- Stage 2 hypertension: **>160/>100**

Exercise, sleep, posture, and stress can all affect blood pressure readings, so if your blood pressure reading is high your doctor may take several readings over time to help confirm a diagnosis.

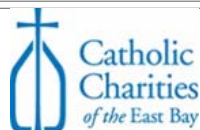
