**June is National Safety Month**

The Dangers of Slips, Trips and Falls: Falls are one of the leading causes of injury in the U.S., accounting for approximately 8.9 million visits to the ER. Falls are the second leading cause of accidental death in homes and communities. The risk of fall related problems rises with age and is a serious issue in homes and communities.

Fall Prevention tips:

- Clean up all spills immediately
- Stay off freshly mopped floors
- Secure electrical and phone cords out of traffic areas
- Remove small throw rugs or use non-skid mats
- Keep frequently used items within easy reach
- Wear shoes with good support & slip resistant soles
- Arrange furniture to provide open walking paths
- Keep drawers and cabinet doors closed
- Install handrails on all stairs on both sides
- Remove tripping hazards from stairs and walkways
- If young children, install gates at the top and bottom of stairs
- Ensure adequate lighting both indoors and outdoors
- Remove debris from exterior walkways
- Adjust gutter downspouts to drive water away from pathways
- Periodically check condition of walkways and steps-repair immediately
- Never stand on a chair, table or other surface on wheels
