## Nurses Notes

Thanks to the kind generosity of the *Women's Fellowship* and the *Knights of Columbus* we now have an *AED (Automatic Electronic Defibrillator)*. The AED is located in the hallway that leads to the offices. It is in the alcove in the northeast corner of the hallway near Room 1a.

The AED can be used by anyone. The machine will take you through the process and it will monitor the patient. **It is critical to call 911 from the office phone not a cell phone and to use the AED immediately when someone is not breathing and/or there is no circulation evident.** For every minute that someone loses breath and circulation there chance of recovery is reduced by 10%. Use of the AED is protected by the Good Samaritan law.

The Faith Community Nurses wish to thank: Fr. Ron, Cal Buckles, Barry Anthony, Al Castinado, Maureen Murray and Lisa Promani who were certified in CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and the use of the AED last week.

The next **4 hour class for CPR and AED proficiency** will be on **June 23, at 5PM**. The class is open to all parishioners and cost is \$25 made payable to St. Anne Church.

The class is limited to 12 people. So sign up at the office today! Remember AED saves lives!

### *Invited to Enter the Intimacy*

This week I often experienced resistance toward private prayer. Every time I tried to sit down and pray alone my thoughts wandered to the book I was reading and wanted to continue reading, to my feelings of hunger, to a monk I couldn't figure out, to a hostile feeling or a daydream I couldn't shake off. Usually I ended up reading a few minutes trying to focus my thoughts again. But when I knelt in front of the Icon of Our Lady of Vladimir, it was different. In some way my resistance against meditation subsided, and I simply enjoyed being invited to enter into the intimacy between Jesus and Mary.

[Abbot] John Eudes didn't run away from the psychological implications of all this. He made me see how masculine my emotional life really is, how competition and rivalry are central in my inner life, and how underdeveloped my feminine side had remained...John Eudes also reminded me that the Hebrew word for God's Spirit, *Ruach*, is both masculine and feminine, and thus emphasizes that God is male and female. Mary helps me to come in touch again with my receptive, contemplative side and to counterbalance my one-sided aggressive, hostile, domineering, competitive side.
