Nurses Notes

Tobacco cessation

Every year in the U.S., more than 480,000 people die from tobacco use and exposure to secondhand smoke, making it the leading cause of preventable death in this country. Every cigarette you smoke shortens your life by 11 minutes.

Effects on health

Smoking and the use of other tobacco products, including cigars and smokeless tobacco, causes or worsens numerous diseases and conditions. Some products also expose nearby people to toxic secondhand smoke. Secondhand smoke is a serious health hazard for people of all ages, causing more than 41,000 deaths each year. Smokeless tobacco products are also a known cause of cancer, and are not a safe alternative to cigarettes nor are electronic cigarettes.

Electronic cigarettes are a new tobacco product, and the potential health consequences and safety of these products are unknown. Smoking increases your risk of heart attack, stroke, lung cancer, throat cancer, diabetes, and emphysema.

Benefits of stopping smoking

Besides saving you money, As soon as you quit, your risk for heart disease begins to go down. After just a year of being smoke-free, your risk of dying from heart disease is cut in half. You'll save on dental bills because smokers can suffer from gum disease and it can stain your teeth. Smokers are twice as likely to lose their teeth. Smoking can cause wrinkles, erectile dis function and many other problems.
