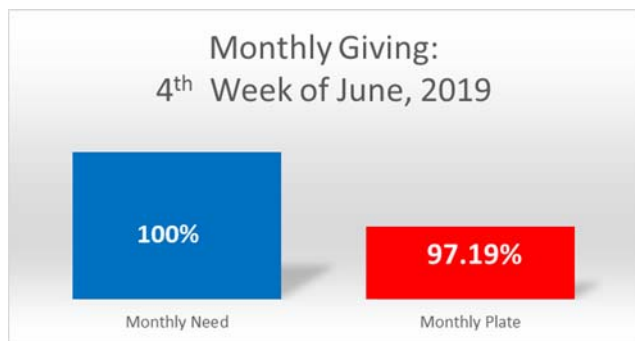

USE MEDICINES SAFELY

Ask questions to make sure you understand.

- To use a medicine safely, you need to know:
- The name of the medicine
- Why you are using the medicine
- How to use the medicine the right way
- If there are any medicines you shouldn't take with this one
- What the side effects could be
- How to get rid of any unused medicine safely

Ask your doctor or nurse questions to be sure you understand how to use your medicine. Take notes to help you remember the answers. You can even ask to record the instructions on your phone.

You can also ask a pharmacist if you forget how to use a medicine or you don't understand the directions.
