Nurses Notes:

Sunscreen

Choosing the right sunscreen can help reduce the chance for skin cancer and reduce early skin aging caused by the sun.

The American academy of dermatology recommends SPF factor of 30 or higher Choose a broad spectrum sunscreen that contains both UVA and UVB protection both of which can cause cancer.

Choose a sunscreen that is water resistant for a minimum of 40 minutes and can be found to last up to 80 minutes. Apply it often, at least every 2 hours especially if you are swimming or have towed off the sunscreen or sweated heavily. Apply it liberally. At least 2 tablespoon is needed to cover your face and body. If you use spray, apply till you get a sheen on your skin.

Finally children's sunscreens aren't just for kids. They contain zinc oxide or titanium oxide. They are less likely to irritate your skin.

Don't forget to cover you nose, hands, ears, neck, toes and lips.
