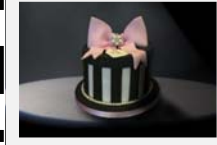

#### ANOTHER BENEFIT OF BREAST FEEDING

We all know that breast feeding is good for babies but new research by Kaiser Permanente reveals benefits for moms too.

Breast cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in women today. Several studies are under way to help understand how lifestyle factors can effect long term outcomes for women who have been diagnosed with breast cancer.

In this study women were followed for nine years after diagnosis. It turns out that women that previously breast fed their babies for any length of time were 28% less likely to die from this disease and had an over all 30 % decreased risk of cancer recurrence.
