## *Nurses Notes*

### Summer is here and things are "Heating Up"

#### SAFETY IN THE SUN

We all need some sun exposure, our primary source of Vitamin D which helps us absorb calcium for stronger, healthier bones. It doesn't take much time in the sun for most people to get the Vitamin D they need. Unprotected exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays can cause skin damage, eye damage, immune system suppression, and even cancer. Even people in their twenties can develop skin cancer and latest research says these young people may have had that exposure when toddlers.

Most children get between 50% to 80% of their lifetime sun exposure before 18. It is important that parents teach their children how to enjoy fun in the sun safely.

The facts about sun exposure:

The sun radiates light to the earth, and part of that light consists of invisible ultraviolet UV rays.

When these rays reach the skin, they cause tanning, burning, and other skin damage. Sunlight contains 3 types of ultraviolet rays: UVA, UVB and UVC. UVA and UVB rays are the ones we should be concerned about since they can cause skin aging, wrinkling, cancer, sunburn, cataracts and immune system damage. UVC rays are mostly filtered by the earth's ozone layer so is not as much of a problem.

Beware of tanning beds because they use UVA rays. A UVA tan does NOT help protect the skin from further damage; it merely produces color and a false sense of protection from the sun.

Melanoma, the most dangerous form of skin cancer is thought to be associated with severe UVB sunburns that occur before the age of 20.
