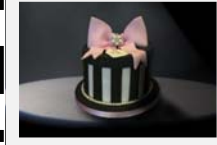

BE HAPPY

By now almost everyone I know has heard the song Be Happy by Pharrel Williams. It makes me happy and brings a smile to my face when I listen to it. It seems to give me energy as well. We all want to be happy but sometimes we seek it in all the wrong places.

It turns out that lasting happiness comes from within ourselves, and it comes from our behaviors, attitudes, and mindset. It is associated with a practiced set of skills.

The research has identified seven principles of happiness: kindness, gratitude, forgiveness, self-compassion, optimism, mindfulness, and connection.

In his book Real Happiness, proven paths for contentment and wellbeing by Jonah Paquette, he outlines examples, skills and exercises that may help in our pursuit of happiness.

A terrific example of one of these exercises is to write down three different things that we are grateful for each day, this can increase our sense of wellbeing and may help us to notice positive things around us.
