Constipation can be a sign you aren't getting enough water or fiber.

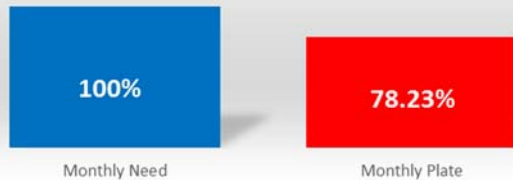
