Nurses Notes

It's been very hot..... Protect your skin.

Skin cancer is the most common form of cancer in the United States. In fact, the American Cancer Society estimates that more than five million skin cancer cases are diagnosed annually. While some people are at an increased risk for skin cancer, individuals of all ethnicities and skin tones can develop it.

The cause? The most significant risk is overexposure to ultraviolet light. The sun's ultraviolet A and ultraviolet B rays (UVA and UVB), as well as the lights used in tanning beds, damage our skin, causing early wrinkles, skin cancer and other skin problems even when we don't burn.

Keep these points in mind:

- Use a sunscreen with a sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30, even on cloudy days
- Reapply every two hours
- Apply enough to cover the entire body – usually about 1 ounce or 5-6 teaspoons
- Make sure your sunscreen provides broad-spectrum protection from both UVA and UVB rays
- Check the expiration date – some ingredients in sunscreen break down over time

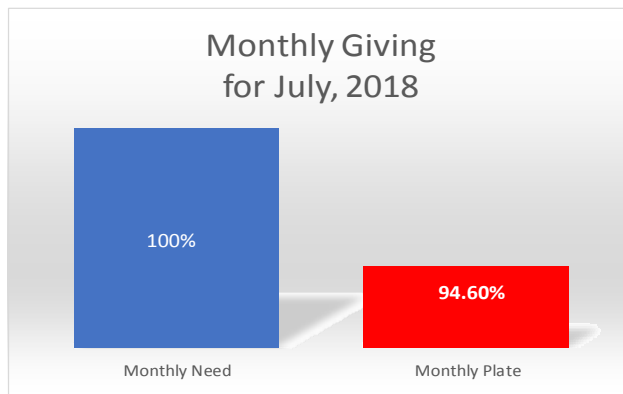

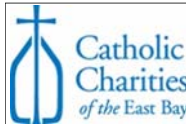
