Nurses Notes

EYE HEALTH

Good eye health and eye care are crucial to protect your sight, prevent common eye disorders, and treat eye problems early.

Because you value your sight, it is important to be proactive in your eye health. Taking a role in maintaining your sight and preventing its loss includes choosing a health care provider best suited for your needs—one who has the right training and experience, can give proper diagnosis and treatment, is informative, promotes the best outcome, and guides your care through genuine concern.

Having a complete eye exam every one to two years is important because most eye diseases can be treated when found at an early stage. If you have any degree of sudden vision loss, eye pain, or significant irritation, contact your eye doctor right away. If you have a contact lens in place, remove it immediately if you experience pain, discharge, or blurred vision and do not replace it until you have been examined.

People with diabetes should see their eye doctor at least yearly. Complications of diabetes include diabetic retinopathy which can lead to blindness. It is critical to receive proper treatment to reduce the chance of losing your vision.

There is a higher risk of certain disorders if someone in your family has had that eye problem. People with a family history of glaucoma, macular degeneration, and corneal diseases may need to see their doctor more frequently.
