Nurses Notes

Dehydration

How much water do we need per day?

It depends. The Most common recommendation is 6-8 glasses of water each day. Depending on your overall health and factors like the medications you take, intensity of exercise and how hot the weather is can affect the need for how much water you need.

Warning signs of dehydration

One of the easiest ways to tell if your getting enough water is by the color of your urine. If it's clear or light yellow then your getting enough water but if it's dark yellow or amber then it's time to hydrate.

Other warning signs of dehydration are:

- Bad breath
- Decreased amount of urine
- Dry mouth or swollen tongue
- Feeling sluggish or fatigued
- Sugar cravings

More severe signs that require medical attention are:

- Confusion
- Dizziness
- Fainting
- Heart palpitations

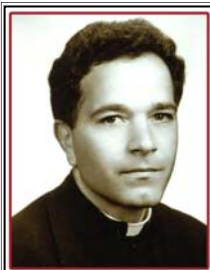
